Staff Connection...

ROMAN MISSAL III

During the Vatican Council II, in the 1960's, we first saw a change in the Mass as it began to be celebrated in the language of the people. Bishops from English speaking countries attending this Council set up the International Commission on English in the Liturgy (ICEL) in Rome in 1963. Today there are 11 full members made up of Bishops from the Bishops' Conferences from Australia, Canada, England and Wales, India, Ireland, New Zealand, Pakistan, the Philippines, Scotland, South Africa and the United States.

One translation was given to the English-speaking Church in the mid 1960's and another in 1973. On March 28, 2001, the Holy See asked that there be a translation which reflects a direct translation from the Latin. This work, under the auspices of ICEL will be ready for us the First Sunday of Advent, 2011.

Our Diocese has asked us to ready ourselves for this by taking several steps in preparation. The first step being to enrich our understanding and appreciation of the Mass. The changes are not bringing about a "new Mass", but a change words to better reflect the Latin translation.

We are looking forward to helping to bring each of us to a richer spiritual experience through our participation at Mass. Our Adult Faith Formation sessions (Thursdays after the 12:10 Mass) will take us through 4 videos on the parts of the Mass. Jan. 20—Go Up with Joy; Jan. 27—The Word of the Lord; Feb. 3—Lift Up Your Hearts; Feb. 10—Say Amen to What You Are. All are welcome to these sessions.

The weekend of Jan. 22/23 there will be a special DVD—**A Moment of Grace**—shown in Church. This is also available on the dor.org website under Parish Support. This DVD includes reflections by Bishop Clark, Father Robert Kenney and Deacon John Brasley. In February, Father will present homilies on the parts of the Mass and there will also be extra pages in the bulletin for you personal reflection.

We are getting together resources to be used during Lent if anyone is interested in gathering with other folks for sharing your personal reflections on what the Mass really means in your life.

In the Fall we are looking towards ordering books which will give good insights to the actual changes being planned.

The actual draft will be finalized later in the year after it goes through one more "fine tuning" of the translation.

In the meantime, let us pray for each other as we move towards a deeper understand and appreciate for the Mass in our daily lives. Let it become alive for us that we may truly go out and celebrate who we are as individuals, gifted by God, because of what we just celebrated in community.

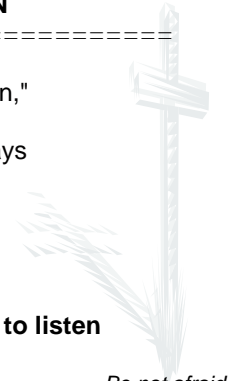

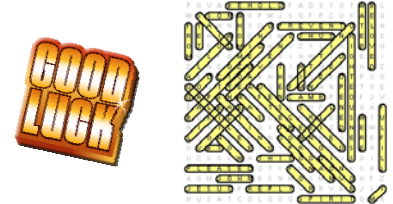
"Soup-er Bowl of Caring" Help us "Tackle Hunger!!"
