



My dear sisters and brothers in Christ:

World Mission Sunday on October 20th this year is a great moment for the entire Church to focus upon our missionary involvement. It is the annual day for prayer and sacrifice when all Catholics in the Diocese of Rochester join Catholics throughout the world in our common effort to sustain the missionary vitality and growth of the Church.

This year marks a very special World Mission Sunday. It takes place during the Extraordinary Missionary Month, called for by Pope Francis, in honor of the 100th anniversary of Pope Benedict XV's Apostolic Letter *Maximum Illud*, which renewed the missionary mandate to proclaim the Gospel. Using the same title for both commemorations, *Baptized and Sent: The Church of Christ on Mission in the World*, Pope Francis writes: "The Church is on mission in the world. Faith in Jesus Christ enables us to see all things in their proper perspective, as we view the world with God's own eyes and heart. Hope opens us up to the eternal horizons of the divine life that we share. Charity, of which we have a foretaste in the sacraments and in fraternal love, impels us to go forth to the ends of the earth (cf. *Micah* 5:4; *Matthew* 28:19; *Acts* 1:8; *Romans* 10:18). A Church that presses forward to the farthest frontiers requires a constant and ongoing missionary conversion."

During this month of October, Pope Francis invites us anew to a personal encounter with Jesus Christ through the sacraments, in prayer and by our charitable participation in "The *missio ad gentes*, (mission to the nations) which is always necessary for the Church...." I encourage you to serve your brothers and sisters in the Developing World with the same generous support that you always have shown in the past. Your prayers and financial gift will advance the day when the whole world will share the faith in the one Lord Jesus Christ.


