
#### **2020 MASS INTENTIONS**

# Peace Week 2019

Since the first Peace Mass in 2009, the Catholic community of Tompkins County has been coming together annually to pray for peace, to tell the truth about the costs of war, and to remember our Christian calling to be non-violent.

"...for Christians, non-violence is not merely tactical behavior but a person's way of being, the attitude of one who is so convinced of God's love and power that he is not afraid to tackle evil with the weapons of love and truth alone." -Pope Benedict XVI

#### Prayer to Live Non-Violently:

Recognizing the violence in our own hearts, yet trusting in the goodness and mercy of God, we ask for the grace to practice the nonviolence of Jesus who taught us in the Sermon on the Mount: Blessed are the peacemakers, for they shall be called the sons and daughters of God...

You have learned how it was said,
"You must love your neighbor and hate your enemy"; but I say to you, "Love your enemies, and pray for those who persecute you.

Before God the Creator and the Sanctifying Spirit, we pray that we would carry out in our lives the love and example of Jesus

by striving for peace within ourselves and seeking to be peacemakers in our daily lives; by accepting suffering rather than inflicting it; by refusing to retaliate in the face of provocation and violence;

by persevering in nonviolence of tongue and heart; by living conscientiously and simply so that we do not deprive others of the means to live;

by actively resisting evil and working nonviolently to abolish war and the causes of war from our own hearts and from the face of the earth;

God, we trust in Your sustaining love and believe that just as You gave us the grace and desire to follow Your Son's example in these ways, so You will also bestow abundant grace to fulfill it.

# Kings Bay Plowshares 7 Update and a Call to People of Faith

Clare Grady, a member of the Ithaca Catholic Worker community, and six other anti-nuclear activists will go on trial on October 21 for an action of civil resistance at Kings Bay Naval Base in Georgia a year ago April. Their name, "Kings Bay Plowshares 7", originates in the prophet Isaiah's call (2:4) for "nations to beat swords into plowshares . . . and neither shall they learn war anymore." They face up to 25 years in prison if found guilty.

On April 4, 2018, the 50th anniversary of the assassination of Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King, the seven Catholic Workers cut holes in the fence at the Naval base. This is the facility where six U.S. Trident nuclear submarines are based, each armed with 20 ballis-



tic missiles, each missile having four or five targetable warheads, each warhead with the capability of carrying seven to thirty times the explosive force as the atomic bomb dropped on Hiroshima. The activists entered the base, spray painted peace messages on walkways, and placed yellow crime scene tape and poured blood on the weapons head-quarters building. They called this a "sacramental action . . . to make sacred that which has been desecrated."

The protesters were arrested and charged with conspiracy, depredation of government property, destruction of Naval Station property, and trespass. All spent months in jail, some later released with ankle monitors, travel restrictions and curfews. Liz McAlister, turning 80 in November, was released only this past September. The seven are preparing for trial and are now in Brunswick, GA.

Come be inspired by the real-life stories of people brave enough to fight for justice and to change their societies without using guns or hatred. A major support movement has been mobilized, building upon past religiously motivated anti-nuclear protests. The Kings Bay petition to drop all charges has been signed by five Nobel Laureates, including Archbishop Desmond Tutu, many dignitaries, and over 7000 other people. This "symbolic disarmament of the base" was the 100th Plowshares action against the ecocide (killing of the Earth) and fratricide (killing of our sisters and brothers) that comes with nuclear war.

The Kings Bay Plowshare 7's argument comes down to this: Trident submarines and our omnicidal nuclear arsenal should be put on trial rather than those who conscientiously object to war and live their deeply held Catholic beliefs in the sanctity of all life and the care for all creation.

Clare Grady asks us to pray for her and all the defendants, for truth and justice to prevail, and for the softening of Federal Judge Lisa Godbey Wood's heart.


