
FOR YOUR SAFETY

To preserve the beauty and dignity of Calvary Cemetery, we have instituted the following rules & regulations for flowers and decorations for our Queen of Peace Mausoleum.

For the safety of all we serve, your cooperation is greatly appreciated.



In 1981, the Queen of Peace Mausoleum was constructed to give families additional burial options. The original construction provided 224 spaces and a structure that can be expanded to meet future needs.

Our mausoleum offers crypts for one, two or four interments. Our crypts are priced according to size and location. We currently have a limited number of crypts available; and a possible future expansion will add additional spaces.

Cremains may be placed in any of our crypts and may also be placed in our Columbarium and Cremation Garden as well as our burial lots. Please refer to the Rules and Regulations for our Columbarium and Cremation Garden brochure.

Entrance to the Mausoleum is with a key-pad. If you wish to enter the Mausoleum, please call the Cemetery Manager to get the access code.

If you have any questions regarding these rules and regulations, please contact the Cemetery Manager.

Mausoleum Decorations

Due to limited space, one vase is allowed per crypt, regardless of the number of entombments or interments. One artificial flower arrangement is allowed and must be placed in a vase secured to the front of the crypt or niche.

All flower decorations must be securely confined to the vase in such a way that they will not fall out during routine mausoleum cleaning and maintenance. Decorations must be of such size as to not infringe on the space provided for flower arrangements for other crypt and niche holders. The flower arrangement should not exceed 12" in height and be of reasonable width/diameter as to not encroach on the space.

The photo of the person must match the name on the crypt. A portrait type photo only showing the person from the waist up are accepted. The photo will be permanently fixed onto the crypt by the Cemetery Manager. To ensure consistency in size, shape and quality, all photos must be approved by the Cemetery Manager prior to being placed.

No objects of any kind of decoration may be placed on the crypt or niche front with the exception of ceramic photos, emblems, and floral decorations as outlined above. No objects of any kind, floral or decorative, may be placed on the floor. Such objects shall be removed and disposed of by the Cemetery Manager. For exterior crypts, flowers may be left at the bottom of a crypt on the sidewalk area. The family is responsible for checking the flowers to ensure they do not become unsightly. They must be disposed of by the family.





Choose Perpetual Care

Calvary Cemetery offers families the security of perpetual care. The Cemetery Manager is available Monday through Friday on site to maintain the grounds and buildings and respond to the needs of our families. Grass is mowed and trimmed, snow is plowed during the winter and the cemetery is kept looking good through all four seasons. We take pride in maintaining a beautiful site that honors those families who have entrusted their loved ones to us. When you purchase a burial lot, crypt, or niche, you receive a certificate of burial privilege and the confidence knowing that we will care for your memorial site for years to come.
