

Time Register for OCIA

New members are welcomed into the Catholic Church through a process of prayer, study, discussion, and a series of ceremonial steps known as the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA). All people who are open to learning more about the Catholic Church are welcome to begin the OCIA process. The process begins in September and ends at the Easter Vigil (the night before Easter).

Those who have never been baptized will prepare to receive Baptism, Confirmation and First Holy Communion. Those who were baptized in another Christian denomination and wish to enter into full communion with the Catholic Church will prepare to receive Confirmation and First Holy Communion.

Those who were baptized Catholic as infants but did not complete the Sacraments of Initiation will prepare to receive Confirmation and (if they had not already done so), First Penance and First Holy Communion.

The OCIA program will begin on September 22 at 6:30pm in the Immaculate conception Parish Hall (basement of the Church). 

Parish Communication

Communicating effectively helps the parish run smoothly. People are kept informed and invited to participate in the life the parish when they know what to do and when. What is the **primary** source of our parish communication? Effective immediately our **weekly bulletin /website** will serve as our primary source of information. The bulletins are published weekly and uploaded to the website and it reaches local and far audience. All ministries are invited to use the weekly bulletin to share information of their respective ministries by submitting their information to the parish office in a timely manner, a week or two before the scheduled events would greatly appreciated. We will endeavor to improve our bulletin by editing it well and making sure that the information is accurate and free from ambiguities.

Secondary source of information: a) Pulpit announcement: Short, limited to one or two items, and mainly reminders to very important/changes to the bulletin announcements.

- b) **ParishApp:** Urgent announcement will reach everyone instantaneously. Ask how to sign up to the parishapp.
- c) **Posters** are effective, they are visual and strategically positioned
- d) **Emails:** Group emails are effective in ministry groups of the parish. Also, we will be sending quarterly important information to all the parishioners.


